### 1. Product description:

EPS S 040 FACADE polystyrene thermal insulation panels are manufactured from expanded polystyrene in accordance with PN-EN 13163+A1:2015-03 "Thermal insulation products for buildings. Factory made expanded polystyrene (EPS) products. Specification." These are rectangular panels with straight or milled edges. Standard panels are produced in the following dimensions: length 1000 mm, width 500 mm, thickness 20 to 300 mm in 10 mm increments.

#### 2. Application:

EPS S 040 FACADE polystyrene panels are intended for thermal insulation in the building industry, mainly for facades,. These products are specifically intended for:

- thermal insulation of walls with cladding elements and ventilated air gap
- thermal insulation of walls in external composite insulating systems
- thermal insulation of tie beams as stay-in-place formwork under plaster
- thermal insulation of lintels and jambs
- thermal insulation in prefabricated external sandwich panels
- thermal insulation of the underside of ceilings in external composite insulating systems
- thermal insulation and stay-in-place formwork for reinforced concrete ceilings
- thermal insulation under load-bearing structures
- thermal insulation of walls including BSO, ETICS (light wet) or (light dry)
